

# Green Organic Waste Collection

Are you questioning what waste to place into the green lid bin? Feel free to refer to the below guide as a reference.

Council have adopted an additional service provision to the residential urban kerbside pickup to include a third bin for green waste. This program enabled the delivery of a 240litre yellow lid mobile garbage bin (mgb) to each residential property to accept recyclables. The 240litre green lid bin then reverted to a green waste bin.

Green waste is collected four weekly, and includes lawn clippings, leaves, cuttings & prunings, and food scraps. Dirt, rocks, bricks & pavers and plastic bags are not to be placed in the green waste bin.

If you currently pay a waste service fee on a commercial property and require a green organics bin, or pay a waste service fee for a residential property and did not get a yellow lid bin, please contact Council.
